1. Explanatory notes

This specific module is incorporated in the Training Modules on Project Management Administration and Accessing Technical, management and financial assistance. It is under

- Chapter 3, Heading 3.5. (Proposal writing) on pages 15 – 16.

During training, participants were given exercises that allowed them to practice on how to prepare proposals. The exercises included:

- Detailed problem analysis using a problem tree to understand the cause-effect relationship of a specific problem.
- Preparation of a results framework. This involved brainstorming of desired results, indicators to check whether results have been achieved or not, baselines, targets, sources of verification etc.
- Information on proposal writing was shared with the participants, including a generic format of a proposal indicating what should be included in a proposal.
